# QUALIFICATION

### VALIDATING THE RELIABILITY OF THE BOAT AND THE SKIPPER'S ABILITIES

Qualify on the boat that will sail the Vendée Globe

Take the start of 2 qualifying solo races of the Globe Series Championship 📀 (including one before end of 2023 and one in 2024). The skipper must finish at least one of them and his or her race time must not be more than one and a half times faster than the winner's time.

## SELECTION

- The first 13 skippers with a new boat taking the start of a qualifying race
- The 26 skippers having sailed the highest number of nautical miles on the selective races of the **Globe** Series Championship 🔹
- If less than 39 skippers are registered, they are automatically selected
- The organizer reserves the right to invite 1 additional skipper among the registered
